

# RULES OF PROCEDURE

## TO READ COMPLETELY BEFORE PRACTICING THE DIFFERENT ACTIVITIES OR PENETRATING ON THE SITE

By purchasing a right of access from PARCOURS AVENTURE 49, for any activity whatsoever, or more simply by entering the site as a visitor without engaging in activities, you accept all the clauses of the present rules. Any visitor to the park is asked to come to the reception before any walk.

You operate on the site and / or on the course (s) at your own risk.

Your responsibility may be questioned if you have contravened the rules and provisions contained in these rules of procedure. It is forbidden to start an activity without having been registered at the reception and have followed the obligatory initiations.

PARCOURS AVENTURE 49 reserves the right to exclude, without any right to any refund, any person who behaves in a way that is dangerous for himself or for others and / or does not respect the present rules. PARCOURS AVENTURE 49 assumes no responsibility for non-compliance with the safety instructions or these internal regulations.

PARCOURS AVENTURE 49 assumes no responsibility for non-compliance with the safety instructions or these internal regulations.

It is reminded here the major safety instructions of the park: it is strictly forbidden to smoke in the enclosure of the park.

Fire and barbecues are prohibited.

Swimming is strictly prohibited.

Fishing is prohibited. Access to animals (dogs ...) is prohibited in the park.

Consumption of alcohol is prohibited in the park.

Access to activities may be denied in case of alcohol or drug use.

Only the activities proposed by the management, namely acrobatic courses, Obstacle Course and Paintball, are authorized and subject to registration with the reception.

Any other activity is strictly forbidden and will be refused by the park management.

Picnic: it is allowed on both delimited areas only, and only for our customers.

You are kindly asked to come to the reception desk beforehand and thank you for bringing your waste with you.

### 1- The Acrobatic courses:

Definition of the activity: The acrobatic courses in height are spaces of ludic activity safe allowing the practitioners to walk in height, independently and more or less acrobatic, on and between the trees or other natural supports or not.

The courses consist of 95 workshops spread over 5 courses + 3 "Briefing".

The activity is carried out with personal protection equipment (type climbing and some courses located at more than 15m high.)

This activity is autonomous in the sense indicated by the instruction of the Ministry of Youth and Sports n° 09- 089JS of July 15, 2009.

This activity is monitored from the ground by: "PARK OPERATORS", recognizable by their colorful clothes that can be marked "PARCOURS AVENTURE 49" on the back.

The practitioner moves in total autonomy in accordance with these. The practitioner uses the equipment and facilities of the park at his own risk, responsible for the deterioration or loss of personal belongings of customers and accompanying persons, or walking on the site or objects entered at the reception or staff park.

### 2-Definition of the service provided:

The service provided includes: a right of access to one or more courses, the supply and installation of the equipment of the practitioners, the description of the activity and the safety instructions and the use of the equipment, the implementation on a test path for validation by an operator and the supervision, advice and / or any help outstanding session.

### 3-Right of access to the courses and entrance to the site:

Against the payment of the chosen formula, the practitioner will be given a ticket validating his registration.

Performing partially or not at all on-course is not entitled to any refund.

Any course begins, followed by an abandonment for some reason will not be refunded.

The same is true if a practitioner is arrested by an operator for security reasons.

The tickets must be presented as proof of its acknowledgment to the operators present on the equipment area and at the beginning of each course.

The site is also accessible free of charge to visitors accompanying practitioners, if they comply fully with the terms of the present regulations.

Visitors must respect the instructions of the operators (not to go beyond the limits of security).

In case Storm, strong wind, it may be asked to the practitioners to leave the courses.

In this case only, if the weather does not allow a continuation of the activity in the hours that follow, new equivalent tickets will be given for one future day in the current calendar year, no refund may be required.

#### 4-Conditions of access to the courses:

To access the courses

It is imperative to:

- Paid an entrance fee at the reception desk in front of the facilities
- To have had the explanations of security instructions at the beginning of the session
- Have good health and no physical problems (heart trouble, back, spine, vertigo.) Activity strongly discouraged to pregnant women ...).
- The practice is prohibited to any person having taken consumption of the alcohol or any other substance which can alter its capacities
- Respect the conditions of safety and support in Chapter 5 of this Regulation.
- have previously taken out individual liability insurance
- have consulted the organization plan of safety and rescue (identification of the persons in charge, emergency telephone numbers, ...)

It is forbidden to smoke and use a mobile phone during the activities.

It is forbidden to smoke throughout the park, under penalty of immediate expulsion

The Direction reserves the right to deny access or to exclude all persons whom it deems to be unsafe.

#### 5- Age conditions, weight and accompaniment

The courses are not possible to people over 100kg for reasons of material constraint.

For the individual. Accompanying children:

White Course (2-5 years) an adult must stay in contact with the children during all the course.

Green course (6 years and 1M20) 1 adult must advise children in the trees.

Blue course (from 9 years, 1M40) 1 adult must advise children in the trees.

Red and Black Course (13 years old, minimum 1, 50m): Children can be supervised by the ground.

For school groups and communities (Center acts, \_\_)

The conditions are different: you must respect the group instructions given at the time of booking with this regulation.

#### 6-Security

**YOU MAKE THE DIFFERENT COURSES IN PRACTICE Autonomous. YOU ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR YOUR own SECURITY.**

Adopt in all circumstances responsible and prudent behavior

##### 6.1 An outfit adapted to the exercise of outdoor activities is highly recommended:

For more ease, a sports outfit is recommended.

Pants, jogging, sneakers, ...

Avoid shorts, sleeveless t-shirt and tie long hair. Tong forbidden.

Parcours Aventure 49 cannot be held responsible for dirt or degradations of clothing and advises participants to privilege non-fragile outfits that can get dirty

The participant must make all the arrangements to avoid any accident:

to tie the hair to avoid the risk of tearing off them in the pulleys

to empty the pockets,

to remove the personal effects which can represent a danger during the activity (jewels, bags, piercing, ...)

It is recommended to wear closed clothes

##### 6.2 Safety equipment

Before leaving. participants must be equipped with a personal protective equipment (PPE) and accessories provided by PARCOURS AVENTURE 49 (harness, lanyards, carabiners, pulley, headlamp for the night routes).

This equipment will be given by an operator after payment of the entrance fee to the reception.

Only the official equipment of PARCOURS AVENTURE 49 is allowed and compatible with the facilities.

This equipment is subject to a systematic visual inspection before each use and a complete periodic inspection according to the standards in force.

The practitioner keeps his equipment throughout the course and does not lend it to anyone.

In the case of a loss, the company PARCOURS AVENTURE 49 will ask the participant to refund the lost equipment on a non-debatable flat rate of 200 Euros.

No personal equipment will be accepted, as will to other activities in the park: paintball, ...

The various protection devices (against falls from height, as well as shocks) are equipments which aim to limit the consequences of fall or shocks. They do not guarantee that the practitioner is systematically unscathed after possible shocks or falls (extract from the CPS 52.902 standard)

It is therefore forbidden to ask unnecessarily or misuse safety equipment put in place (personal protection equipment, anti-falls, workshops, ...)

The participants undertake to respect the equipment (platform, cables, PPE ..).

In the event of a deliberate degradation, Parcours Aventure 49 will invoice the deteriorated equipment at the purchase price

## 6.3 security conditions

### 6.3-1 For practitioners only:

The participants must attend the safety briefing (instructions-CUMED).

It allows to show and put into practice rules of safety and the adaptation to the material as well as the different kinds of workshops (passages between 2 trees, net, zip line, ...)

They must also pass on the training course CUMED to put into practice these safety instructions and test its capabilities.

Anyone who, at the end of the briefing and the test course, does not feel able, physically or morally, to perform correctly the necessary manipulations for a self-insurance evolution Must give up the activity. The park staff reserves the right to deny access to anyone who does not have sufficient physical or motor skills on these training courses

- The participant is responsible for observing the safety instructions and must constantly personally ensure his movement in the trees by staying permanently connected to the lifelines (secure cables marked by red plastics).

-The participant must systematically read the signage of each workshop and scrupulously respect the instructions mentioned therein.

- Only one person at a time must be on a workshop; 2 people maxima can park on a platform, even if it is recommended to park only one person also.

It is strictly forbidden to detach safety systems such as carabiners once in trees even at a height of 1 meter.

It is forbidden to interrupt and / or leave a route before the end without the authorization and assistance of an operator.

Participants resuming the activity, after a break, must have their personal protective equipment checked again by one of the Operators.

- For safety reasons, any person weighing more than 100kg will not be able to access certain courses in the trees.

- Please inform the monitors at the reception to direct you to suitable courses.

- For people wearing eyeglasses or sunglasses, it is advisable to remove them.

- In any case, the management cannot be held responsible for the loss or the deterioration of the glasses, clothing, cell phones and other personal items left in the enclosure of the park.

### 6.3-2 For all (practitioners and accompanying persons, walkers ..)

In case of any problem, please notify the park staff by any useful means

All staff have been trained to meet service and security requirements.

It is dangerous to circulate under the platforms and courses because of the possibilities of falling objects (phones, pulleys, apple pines ...)

- Always stay on marked trails and read the signage provided for this purpose: it is strictly forbidden to cross the boundaries of marked trails (cords, barriers ..), even to take pictures, to avoid any risk and respect trees and vegetation.

-It is forbidden to run in the aisles or to drive in a motorized vehicle or not (bicycle, mow, ...)

-You are not allowed to smoke in the park

- Dogs may be frightened. Some people may be frightened during the activity. They are forbidden in the park.

- The management of the park is relieved of any responsibility in the event of an accident occurring to walkers in the park: burns, cuts, insect bites and other animals, drownings, falls in a hole, ...

-Swimming is strictly forbidden in the park. Children must be supervised always by a responsible adult.

## 6.4 Weather conditions:

Activity is possible even in rainy weather.

However, in case of bad weather (storm, earthquakes, ..) if the activity turns out to be dangerous , it must obligatorily terminate the courses and follow instructions given by those responsible.

More generally, PARCOURS AVENTURE 49 reserves the right to interrupt all activities if it considers that the safety of the practitioners is compromised.

In this case, respect the instructions given by the park staff and do not detach the lifelines.

6.4-1 : For all activities offered by PARCOURS AVENTURE 49, inside and outside the park, the security rules specified above apply.

## 7- Specific regulations for the practice of Paintball

Paintball is a playful sport practiced in compliance with the rules of safety and strict behavior for the pleasure and safety of all players.

This is by no means a contact sport. This is why any serious breach of the security rules results in the expulsion without notice of the player (s) and without any refund.

Access to the field: Paintball is a physically demanding activity; each player declares to be in good physical and moral condition to practice paintball.

He will have to fill in the obligatory registration form given to the reception desk and accept these rules of procedure. Practitioners must wear proper attire for the practice of paintball, that is, a long-sleeved sweater (no T-shirt), pants (no shorts), closed shoes (walking shoes or sport shoes).

Although the paint is washable with water. The management declines any responsibility in the event of damage to the clothing of the players or the spectators.

The use of alcohol or drugs is not compatible with the practice of paintball. Anyone who is suspected of being intoxicated will be denied access to the land.

The activity is reserved for people over 18 years old.

For minors an authorization must be completed and signed by one of the parents or legal guardian or a responsible adult.

The management reserves the right to ask for the identity card of the players to check their age.

Minor participants undertake to behave in a calm and responsible manner for the practice of such activity.

For minor under 14 years, a power adjustment will be made to limit impacts.

In addition, it cannot be mixed with adults or minors over 14 years old.

Security: By signing the registration form, participants agree to respect the security rules posted at the reception, given during the briefing and quoted on the rules of procedure.

-The wearing of the mask is mandatory on the playground; it must not be removed under any circumstances.

- Prohibition to shoot someone less than 10 meters.

- Prohibition of shooting someone who has his arm raised or seems to be in difficulty.

- Put the cap (yellow cap) and the safety catch right out of the playing area.

Do not remove them before entering the playing area.

- Do not climb on obstacles.

-Do not lift the protective nets.

-Every verbal or physical violence is strictly forbidden

The management assumes no responsibility of the persons if the safety rules are not scrupulously respected and reserves the right to lodge a complaint against a customer being accidental following the non-compliance with the safety instructions

Insurance: the practice of paintball is not necessarily covered by your civil liability. Parcours Aventure 49 is insured by a professional civil liability with AXA. The management declines all responsibility in the event of theft or damage to the site or the car park.

Sanctions: The management reserves the right to exclude without warning any person who does not respect the security rules or who displays an aggressive and non-fair attitude.

It cannot claim any type of refund whatsoever.

Material: the material provided must be used with care, any voluntary degradation will be charged to the team leader:

- launcher broken 350euros,

- launcher damaged but repairable package 100 euros,

- launcher lost or stolen 350 euros.

- Helmet broken 25 euros.

- Torn plastron 25 euros

During the game, players must immediately report a malfunction on their Equipment.

Reservations: in season, a deposit check (not cashed) of 150 euros can be requested. The reservation is not confirmed until the receipt of this check.

In case of cancellation of the group less than 48 hours before, the check will be cashed without possibility of dispute.

#### 8-Respect for the environment

The forest is a fragile environment; the trampling of the soil degrades the vegetation and kills the trees.

Participants undertake to respect the environment (trees, fauna, flora) and to stay on marked trails. It is therefore forbidden to go beyond the barriers and ropes delimiting these paths, tearing plants, picking flowers or mushrooms ...

Dogs and other animals are not accepted on the site. They can affect the good development of the species present on the park.

It is forbidden to light a fire or to barbecue.

Smoking is not allowed.

All waste resulting from products sold on the park will be recycled by us.

For people, groups coming on the spot for lunch, thank you to bring home your garbage.

Fishing is prohibited, as is any form of hunting or poaching.

#### 9-Opening and closing times:

Access to the park is permitted only during park opening hours and is restricted to activity practitioners and their companions.

Access is strictly forbidden outside opening hours. The access to the courses is prohibited outside the opening hours and without authorization of the direction.

Free access is allowed to "Nuits Insolites", on the sole condition that they comply with this regulation.

Check-in times for "Nuits Insolites" are between 17h and 10h. (for the low season between 17h and 18h). After 19h (18h in low season) the park management reserves the right to refuse any person entering the park and to cancel the service without warning or compensation.

Departures: in the morning are set at 11h maximum.

After 11:00, the park management reserves the right to charge overtime on the base of 15 euros / hour.

#### 10-Insurance:

Parcours Aventure 49, commercial name: SARL with a capital of 1000 euros, domiciled in Longué (49460): contracts professional liability insurance with AXA Assurances.

The courses are subject to a technical control and an annual forest control, carried out by approved companies.

The certificates are on display.

Checks are carried out by the management, any anomaly being recorded in a dedicated notebook.

In case of dispute, only the court of Angers is deemed competent.

#### 11-Groups, Visitors:

Anyone entering the enclosure is asked to come to the reception, even if they do not wish to register for the proposed activities.

The reading of the rules of procedure is obligatory in all cases.

Visitors are required to respect the interior regulations under pain of eviction or prosecution.

Groups: any group wishing to book an activity or choose options or external activities offered by the park, must complete and sign the document: Group booking form and pay a deposit check of 150 euros.

In the case of ordering of external services of restoration type or rental of marquee or other, it will be established a quote and a request to the client 100% of the sum of these services on booking.

In case of non-payment, the benefits will not be insured. In case of cancellation of all or part of the group on the part of the customer, in less than 60 days, the deposit will be retained as compensation; no refund will be required from the customer.

Only the following weather conditions may justify a cancellation of the activity in the deposit or accommodation on site: storms, thunderstorms, wind over 60 km / h.

The management of the park informs its customers that the rain allows the practice of all activities of Adventure Course 49. It is not a reason for cancellation of reservation.

In any case, Parcours Aventure 49 must be informed as soon as possible.

In case of cancellation by the management of the park, the deposit will be returned to the customer. The group leader who signed the Group document undertakes to inform all participants in his group of the main precautions to be taken and noted in this regulation.

These main precautions also emphasize the following major points: the customer agrees not to leave waste on site, to inform participants that swimming is prohibited, that fires and barbecues are prohibited, that it is prohibited to smoke, that animals are prohibited within the park, and that the consumption of alcohol and drugs is prohibited.

Access to activities will be systematically denied to anyone who has consumed alcohol or taken substances prohibited by law.

For accommodations on the park, the same conditions apply: no cancellation will be accepted without the written consent of the park management.

No deferral to refund will be made.

In the event of a storm during the night, the customer is informed that he must evacuate the site and go to a hotel or standard accommodation.

In this case only, with the agreement of the park management, a credit can be made within 30 days of the initial date.

An invoice of 250 euros will be sent to anyone who has damaged the accommodations: traces of cigarettes, torn closure, pierced mattresses, ....

It is reminded that it is forbidden to eat, drink and smoke inside the accommodation, a terrace is provided for this purpose.
